## APPEAL

THE APPELLANTS APPEAL to the Federal Court of Appeal from the order of Associate Chief Justice Gagné of the Federal Court dated the 5th day of April 2022 by which Associate Chief Justice dismissed an application for judicial review by the appellants of the decision of Everett L. Harper, Acting Manager Other Government Department (OGD) Programs, Canada Border Services Agency, Government of Canada dated January 13, 2021 to reject the request of the appellants to prohibit the importation of goods produced in Xianjiang, China unless there is clear and convincing evidence that the goods have not been produced wholly or in part by forced labour.

THE APPELLANTS ASK THAT:

this Court allow this appeal and set aside the decision of Everett L. Harper to reject the request of the appellants to prohibit the importation of goods produced in Xianjiang, China unless there is clear and convincing evidence that the goods have not been produced wholly or in part by forced labour.

THE GROUNDS OF APPEAL are:

1. the decision of the Federal Court was wrong in law, and
2. findings of fact of the Federal Court were the subject of palpable and overriding error.
