





## APPEAL

THE APPELLANT APPEALS to the Federal Court of Appeal from the order of the Honourable Justice Henry S. Brown dated December 30, 2020 by which the Court dismissed the application for judicial review in Court file T-816-19 in respect of the decision of the Canadian Human Rights Commission (the "Commission") dated March 27, 2019.

THE APPELLANT ASKS that the Federal Court of Appeal

1. allow this appeal;
2. set aside the Federal Court's order;
3. allow the application for judicial review;
4. quash the decision of the Commission;
5. render the judgement that should have been rendered by the Federal Court;
6. award the costs of this appeal and the proceeding below;
7. such further and other relief as counsel may request and this Honourable Court deems appropriate.


THE GROUNDS OF APPEAL are as follows:

The Federal Court erred in law and fact:

1. in ruling as inadmissible Exhibit "I" in Appellant's affidavit;
2. in finding that the decision of the Commission did not violate principles of natural justice and procedural fairness;
3. in finding that the decision of the Commission was reasonable;
4. in dismissing without due consideration the issue raised by Appellant regarding Respondent's conduct;

5. in misconstruing relief sought by the Appellant;
