**Application (For a Judicial Review)**

This is an application for judicial review in respect of the Canada Revenue Agency ("CRA") third review of the Canada Recovery Benefits ("CRB") dated March 21, 2023 under reference C0055038045-001-45 stating:

"You did not earn at least \$5,000 (before taxes) of employment or self-employment income in 2019, 2020, or in the 12 months before the date of your first application."

The applicant makes application to:

- a) Set aside the opinion and decision of the CRA dated March 21, 2023, and
- b) Guide the CRA to pay the CRB for the periods unpaid.

The grounds for the application are:

- a) In 2019, I earned \$5,000 from employment and self-employment. I provided that information to the CRA;
- b) That the statement of the Respondents that I did not earn at least, \$5,000 in 2019, is factually incorrect;
- c) The CRA was not transparent; it did not respond to my enquiries;
- d) That the Decision of the Respondents was unreasonable, erroneous and arrived at in a procedurally unfair manner, without regard to the principles of natural justice; and
- e) Section 18 of the Federal Court Act
