APPEAL

THE APPELLANTS APPEAL to the Federal Court of Appeal from the order of Justice Grammond dated January 19, 2023, by which the Appellants' motion to appeal a scheduling order of a case management judge was denied and costs were awarded against them.

THE APPELLANT ASKS that the orders of Justice Grammond dated January 19, 2023 be set aside and replaced with an order granting the Appellants leave to challenge the Federal Courts' jurisdiction to hear and determine the Respondents' applications for judicial review and to stay any interlocutory orders respecting the same until such time the issue of the Federal Court's jurisdiction is decided in its finality.

THE GROUNDS OF APPEAL are as follows:

- Justice Grammond erred by holding that the Federal Court had jurisdiction to hear and determine
 the Respondents' motions for interlocutory relief prior to determining the Court's jurisdiction to hear
 the underlying judicial review application.
 - a. In particular, Justice Grammond erred by holding that the motion of the Respondents (Applicants) for interlocutory relief could proceed for hearing and determination prior to allowing the Appellants (Respondents) the time and space to advance their motion challenging the Court's jurisdiction to judicially review the internal governance decisions of Carry the Kettle First Nation and by extension the Court's jurisdiction to grant interlocutory relief in relation to the same.
