## APPLICATION

This is an application for judicial review in respect of SOCIAL SECURITY TRIBUNAL Appeal Division, File Number AD-23-101. The decision date was March 22, 2023, which I received March 28, 2023, and the Tribunal Member was Kate Sellar. Kate Seller refused permission to appeal. Kate Sellar dismissed my Documents to prove Andrew Williamson in his Affidavit made a number of mistakes and miscalculations which led to an administrative error when he tried to calculate my CPP Retirement Pension.

The SST General Division acted unfairly. The Hearing by phone was held June 28, 2022. June 21, 2022, 47 pages of evidence from ESDC that was emailed to me by SST General Division. June 28, 2022, after the Hearing, I received 15 pages of evidence from ESDC that was emailed to me by SST General Division. Both R. Geit and Andrew Williamson made administrative errors when calculating my CPP Retirement Pension which led to another administrative error when calculating my CPP Survivor Pension.

The applicant makes application to quash the Social Security Tribunal Appeal Division decision send this review back to the Minister, to place me in the position that I would be in under the Act had the erroneous advice not been given or the administrative error not been made.

Any further orders that this Honorable Court may permit.

Pursuant to ss 66(4) of the Canada Pension Act, where a person denied benefit due to departmental error, etc. Where the minister is satisfied that a result of erroneous advice or administrative error in the administration of the Act, any person has been denied

(a) a benefit, or portion thereof, to which that person would have been entitled under the Act the Minister shall take such remedial action as the Minister considers appropriate to place the person in the position that the person would be in under this Act had the erroneous advice not been given or the administrative error not been made.

Administrative errors were made when my Canada Pension Survivor Pension and Canada Pension Retirement were calculated.

Grounds to be argued include Canada Pension Act Sections: 42(1) (b)(ii), 46 (1), (3.1), (7), Section 51, Exception 51(2), 66.4, 113.1(1), 113(2), 113(13), 113(14), 115.(1.11) and

Consumer price index table 18, archived- annual weekly earning, all employees(SEPH)  
by standard industrial classification 1960 (SIC)Table 14.
