

## Application

This is an application for judicial review in respect of

Canada Revenue Agency Second Review for Canada Recovery Benefit Application.

Letter Date July 5, 2022 refusing my application and requiring that I repay the benefit. I read this letter on July 5, 2022.

The applicant makes application for: A judicial Review of this decision

The grounds for the application are:

On November 26, 2020, I received a letter from the CRA putting my CRB payments on hold and requesting that I submit proof of earnings for 2019.

On November 30, 2020 I submitted, by facsimile, my response. On a January 3 phone call to the CRA, I learned that nothing was in my file. So I re-submitted, both by facsimile and regular mail, a second copy of my response. This was done on January 3, 2021.

I heard nothing from CRA and, beginning in March of 2021, I started calling then weekly to find out the status of my CRB account.

In a call in late March (very close to March 26, 2021), I was told that the Red Flag on my account had been lifted and I was free to resume filing my current claims and to recover all back payments, which I did. I continued to make my CRB claims until the programme ended in October 2021.
