

This is an application for judicial review in respect of: the decision of the Canada Emergency Benefits Validation of May 10, 2023, Reference No. C0057261677-001-45.

The applicant makes application for:

- a. Restore the original eligibility of the Emergency Benefits (CRB).

The grounds for the application are:

- a. The applicant did earn at least \$5,000 (before taxes) of net self-employment income in the 12 months before the date of my first application.
- b. Respondent's email dated May 10, 2023, Reference No. C0057261677-001-45 erroneously and unfounded states that
 1. "You did not earn at least \$5,000 (before taxes) of employment or net self employment income in 2019, 2020, or in the 12 months before the date of your first application." and

2. "As you did not meet the eligibility criteria to qualify for CRB, any future CRB applications will be denied unless you can provide proof that you are able to satisfy the eligibility criteria".
