APPLICATION

This is an application for judicial review in respect of a decision dated June 1, 2023 (2023 FPSLREB 57) rendered by David Orfald, a panel of the Federal Public Sector Labour Relations and Employment Board ("Board"), wherein the Board allowed a grievance referred to adjudication by the respondent.

The National Research Council of Canada ("NRCC" or "the employer") is a separate agency responsible for, among other things, undertaking, assisting or promoting scientific and industrial research across Canada. Their employees are paid pursuant to a collective agreement, which applies in the same fashion to all regardless of physical location in the country.

The respondent was employed by the NRCC as Client Services Team Lead in Ottawa, Ontario. She initially began a period of sick leave with pay on January 31, 2019, which subsequently became sick leave without pay as of April 17, 2019. She mistakenly continued to be paid until June 12, 2019. On May 10, 2022, the employer notified the employee that it would recover the overpayment she had received between April 17 and June 12, which amounted to a sum of \$7673.95.

The respondent filed a grievance challenging the recovery of the overpayment on the basis that the employer was time-barred under the two-year limitation period in Ontario. The NRCC denied the grievance on the basis that it properly commenced the recovery of the overpayment within the applicable six-year federal limitation period. The respondent referred the grievance to adjudication at the Board pursuant to section 209(1)(a) of the *Federal Public Sector Labour Relations Act* (S.C. 2003, c. 22, s. 2).

The Board allowed the grievance on the basis of an erroneous interpretation of section 32 of the *Crown Liability and Proceedings Act* (R.S.C., 1985, c. C-50) ("*CLPA*"), despite binding jurisprudence to the contrary. As a result, the Board ordered the NRCC to cease the payroll deductions for the recovery of the overpayment and to reimburse the respondent the total sum of the deductions.

The applicant makes application for:

- (a) An order allowing this application for judicial review, with costs;
- (b) An order setting aside the Board's decision dated June 1, 2023;
- (c) An order remitting the matter back to the Board for reconsideration in accordance with the reasons of this Court; and
- (d) Such further and other relief as counsel may request and this Court may deem just or appropriate.

The grounds for the application are:

- 1. The Board erred in law and/or rendered an unreasonable decision by:
 - (a) unreasonably interpreting section 32 of the *CLPA*;
 - (b) failing to consider the text, context, and purpose of the CLPA;
 - (c) conflating principles of collective agreement interpretation with those of statutory interpretation;
 - (d) departing from a prior Board decision in *Dansou v. Canada Revenue*Agency, 2020 FPSLREB 100, without proper justification;
 - (e) departing from a binding Supreme Court of Canada decision in Markevich v. Canada, 2003 SCC 9, without proper justification; and/or
 - (f) issuing a decision that produces an absurd result whereby the employer's salary overpayment recovery would vary from one province to another.

- 2. Paragraphs 18.1(4), (c), (d) and (f) of the Federal Courts Act; and/or
- 3. Such other grounds as counsel may advise and this Court may permit.

The application will be supported by the following material:

- (g) The affidavit(s) of affiant(s) to be identified, which will include *inter* alia the record of the materials that was before the Board; and
- (h) Such further and other material as counsel may advise and this Court may permit.
