ORDER

WHEREAS the appellant filed a motion, dated June 24, 2024, seeking an order abridging the time limits prescribed by the *Federal Courts Rules*, SOR/98-106, proposing a schedule for the steps to be taken to prepare the appeal for hearing, and seeking an expedited hearing of the underlying appeal;

AND WHEREAS the parties have agreed to a proposed schedule and, by joint letter dated June 27, 2024, have provided potential dates for the expedited hearing;

AND WHEREAS the Court is satisfied that it is appropriate in the circumstances to amend the timelines from those provided in the *Federal Courts Rules* and to accommodate the parties' request for a hearing in early September, 2024;

AND WHEREAS the appellant has filed the agreement as to the contents of the appeal book;

AND WHEREAS the parties have advised the Court that the appeal book has been served but not filed pending this Court's decision on the informal motion by the parties for a confidentiality order;

AND WHEREAS the Court has issued a confidentiality order contemporaneously with this order;

THIS COURT ORDERS that:

- 1. The appellant shall file the appeal book and its memorandum of fact and law on or before July 23, 2024. The appellant shall file a public version of the appeal book and its memorandum of fact and law no later than July 29, 2024.
- 2. By August 6, 2024, the respondents shall each serve and file a memorandum of fact and law. The respondents shall have until August 12, 2024 to file a public version of their memorandum of fact and law.
- 3. The joint book of authorities or books of authorities shall be filed no later than August 12, 2024

4. A bilingual hearing of this appeal shall take place in Ottawa on September 3 or 4, 2024. The date, time and duration of the hearing of the appeal will be set by a scheduling order of the Court to be subsequently issued to the parties.
