

This is an application for judicial review in respect of Canada Agricultural Review Tribunal (CART).

Details: Fedorenko v Canada Border Services Agency, 2023 CART 04

Decision Date: January 17, 2023

Date first communicated: January 17, 2023

Order: I find that Ms. Fedorenko contravened section 16(1) of the HA Act as outlined in the Notice and must pay the penalty of \$1300 to the Agency within 90 days of this decision.

The applicant makes application for: I would like to ask the Federal Court of Appeal to cancel the Tribunal's decision, as well as the Notice of Violation numbered 4971-22-0055 issued by the Agency and set aside the penalty of \$1,300 as I did not contravened section 16(1) of the HA Act.

The grounds for the application are: In making its decision, the Tribunal made a legal error when concluded that the Agency had legally accused me of violating section 16(1) of the HA Act. I will support my evidence by the Section 16(1) of the HA Act, Section 12(1) of the Customs Act, and Section 40 of the Regulations.
