APPEAL

This is an appeal pursuant to section 27(1)(a) of the Federal Courts Act.

THE APPELLANT APPEALS to the Federal Court of Appeal from the Order of Justice Go of the Federal Court, dated December 12, 2023, by which the Appellant's application for judicial review of the Veterans Review and Appeal Board decision 100004917561, dated June 9, 2023, denying reconsideration of its previous decision, was dismissed.

THE APPELLANT ASKS to set aside the judgement of Justice Go on Federal Court file T-1474-23 dated December 12, 2023 and return the matter back to the Veterans Review and Appeal Board (VRAB) for assessment of the Appellant's claimed condition of cardiorespiratory impairment.

THE GROUNDS OF APPEAL are as follows.

- 1. The Appellant believes the following decisions of Justice Go were palpable and overriding errors:
 - 1.1. Conclusion that the Appellant has failed to prove his allegations of bias with respect to the Reconsideration Panel.
 - 1.2. Evaluation of Dr. Stuart's report dated April 17, 2018 as insignificant evidence to support the Appellant's claim.
 - 1.3. Conclusion that Veterans Review and Appeal Board was correct in finding no evidence in support a change in the current rating of the Appellant's disability.
 - 1.4. Conclusion that the Reconsideration Panel's reasons meet the hallmarks of intelligibility, transparency and justification.
- 2. The Appellant believes that Justice Go was incorrect in finding that the Reconsideration Panel did not commit a reviewable error by not taking into account multiple medical evidence supporting the Appellant's claim and not drawing every reasonable inference in favour of the Appellant contrary to section 39 of the Veterans Review and Appeal Board Act.
- 3. The Appellant believes that Justice Go was incorrect in conclusion that the Appeal Panel at reconsideration did not have jurisdiction over the Appellant's claim for cardiorespiratory impairment as the Panel was restricted only to section 32(1) of the Veterans Review and Appeal Board Act and was not subject to sections 26 and 29 of the same Act.

THE APPEALLANT proposed the hearing of the appeal to be held in Edmonton, Alberta.
