APPEAL

THE APPELLANT APPEALS to the Federal Court of Appeal from the Judgment of the Honourable Justice Pallotta of the Federal Court, dated July 21, 2023, in court file number T-2250-22 (the "Judgment"), by which the summary application initiated by the Minister of National Revenue (the "Minister") for a compliance order under section 231.7 of the *Income Tax Act*, RSC, 1985, c 1 (5th Supp) (the "Act") was dismissed with costs to the Respondent. The place proposed for the hearing of the appeal is Toronto, Ontario.

THE APPELLANT ASKS that:

- 1. the appeal be allowed;
- 2. the Federal Court's Judgment, including any award of costs, be set aside;
- 3. this Court give the judgment that the Federal Court should have given and compel the Respondent to produce the required information and documentation to the Minister pursuant to section 231.2 of the Act;
- 4. costs be awarded to the Appellant, both in this Court and the Federal Court; and
- 5. such further and other relief as counsel for the Appellant may advise and this Court may permit.

THE GROUNDS OF APPEAL are as follows:

- 1. the Federal Court erred in law in its interpretation and application of the doctrine of abuse of process;
- 2. the Federal Court erred in law in its interpretation and application of sections 231.2 and 231.7 of the Act;

- 3. the Federal Court erred in law and in fact in concluding that the Minister's purpose in issuing the section 231.2 requirement was to verify the unnamed persons' compliance with the Act;
- 4. the Federal Court erred in law in declining to issue a compliance order for the portions of the section 231.2 requirement that did not deal with unnamed persons;
- 5. the Respondent's arguments advanced in the Federal Court challenging the validity of the requirement constitute an impermissible collateral attack on the judgments of the Federal Court dated April 26, 2021, and this Court dated September 27, 2022, which upheld the validity of the requirement.
- 6. sections 230, 231, 231.1, 231.2, and 231.7 of the Act;
- 7. sections 27 and 52 of the *Federal Courts Act*, RSC 1985, c F-7; and
- 8. such further and other grounds as counsel for the Appellant may advise and this Court may permit.
